How to get there:

By Air:

The nearest airports to the province are the Laguindingan Airport in Misamis Oriental and the Ozamis Airport in Ozamiz City in Misamis Occidental. From these airports, you may travel via land to any destination in Lanao del Norte.

By Land:

Each city and municipality in the province has its own bus terminal that has trips to and from Cagayan de Oro, Ozamiz, and other parts of the province.

By Sea:

The province's capital, Iligan City, is also reachable via ferry trips from shipping lines that hold trips from any point in the country going to the city.

Lanao del Norte's Top Destinations



Mt. Torong-Torong

📍 Tubod, Lanao del Norte

Mt. Torong-Torong boasts breathtaking grandeur, with its summit offering a stunning vista of Panguil Bay. Nestled between Tubod, Kolambugan, and a small portion of Magsaysay, this majestic peak reaches heights of 2,500 to 3,000 feet above sea level. Mt. Torong-Torong has been acknowledged by nature trekkers and mountaineers as an amazing venue for regular climbs and adventure tours.



Cathedral Falls

📍 Kapatagan, Lanao del Norte

The rectangular stone structures of this 35-foot waterfall gave it the name "Cathedral Falls," as they resemble the pipe organ, which is usually played in churches. One does not need to wander far to reach the stunning Cathedral Falls, as it is located just 5-10 minutes away from the bustling Kapatagan town center. The locals hold this natural wonder close to their hearts as it is one of the most-visited waterfalls in Lanao del Norte.



Pikalawag Beach

📍 S. N. Dimpaoro, Lanao del Norte

Pikalawag Beach, located in Sultan Naga Dimpaoro, is loved for its incredibly fine sand and vibrant marine ecosystem combined with an exciting package of water activities at your fingertips. Indulge in the sun as you spend the whole day playing in the waves. Get lost in an afternoon of play and fun in its Inflatable Playground, open to all tourists of all ages. Do not also forget to explore the potential dive spots here to complete your limitless underwater adventures.

Pasi Taytayan Boardwalk

📍 Bacolod, Lanao del Norte

Jardin de Rachma

📍 Magsaysay, Lanao del Norte

Be captivated by Magsaysay's multitiered flower farm. The best time to visit this vibrantly colored wonderland is in the afternoon, when the sun gently shines on the profusion of plants, creating the perfect backdrop for your next Instagrammable shot. The main attraction is a giant golden kettle located at the center of the farm that looks like it is pouring fresh water into a ceramic cup.



Mt. Inayawan & Lake Nunungan

📍 Nunungan, Lanao del Norte

At the heart of the biggest municipality of Lanao del Norte, Nunungan, sits the mountain range of Mt. Inayawan. It stands at an astonishing height of 1,535 meters (5,036 feet) above sea level, making it the highest mountain in the province. Lake Nunungan, one of the highest lakes in the country, also sits peacefully in the Mount Inayawan Range while providing residents with a broad stretch of freshly abundant flora and fauna.



Dapit Alim Shrine

📍 Tubod, Lanao del Norte

The Dapit Alim Shrine is known as "a place, invitation and nearness to God, creation and one another." Father Dong Galenzoga and the members of Kahigalaan ni Hesus founded this peaceful ecumenical space. It is a place for prayer, healing, contemplation, meditation, and retreat and is open to people of all faiths and religions. It is perched on a hill overlooking Panguil Bay, with a view of the spectacular Mt. Malindang in the distance.
