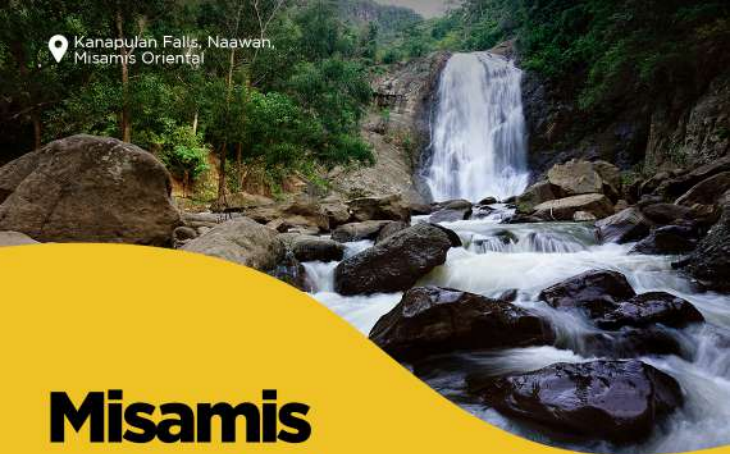

## How to get there:

### By Air:

From Laguindingan Airport, take a bus, a car rental, or an airport shuttle to the Province's metropolitan center, Cagayan de Oro.

### By Land:

The two main bus terminals that hold trips to all points of the province are in Cagayan de Oro City: the Westbound Terminal for trips to the western portion of the province; the Agora Bus Terminal, which holds trips to municipalities and the City of Gingoog, which is located in Agora, Lapasan, Cagayan de Oro City.

### By Sea:

All major shipping lines have direct boat trips to Cagayan de Oro from major sea ports like Manila, Cebu, Iloilo, and Bohol.

# Misamis Oriental's Top Destinations



## Halseyle Hill

📍 Sugbongcogon, Mis. Or.

This picturesque place sits on the majestic hills of Poblacion, Sugbongcogon. It has a breathtaking view of Macajalar Bay and the beautiful island of Camiguin. Tourists flock to the area to enjoy the sights and to take photos in its most instagrammable spot. After sightseeing, you can treat yourself to a sumptuous meal at Halseyle Hill's Cafe Maria with their specialty Texas Style Beef Burger, Sun-dried Tomato Pasta, toffee caramel pancake, and their very famous signature drink, the flavored pops.



## Divine Mercy Shrine

📍 El Salvador, Mis. Or.

The Divine Mercy Shrine is a pilgrimage site located in El Salvador City, featuring the wondrous 50-foot statue of the Divine Mercy that stands on the hills overlooking Macajalar Bay. Since its creation, devotees have come from all points of the globe to visit the statue and the lush landscape surrounding it to rejoice in the presence and miracle of the Divine Mercy of the Lord.



## Immaculate Conception Church

The Immaculate Conception Church in Jasaan, Misamis Oriental is a designated National Cultural Heritage Treasure. Constructed in the early 20th century, this well-preserved church showcases notable architectural elements such as original brick paving, neo-Gothic retablos, intricately crafted ceiling woodwork resembling a basket-weave pattern, and two towers adorned with four church bells.

## Agutayan White Island

📍 Jasaan,  
Mis. Or.

This crescent-shaped sandbar off the coast of Jasaan is a sanctuary for marine wildlife. Clear turquoise waters surround this white sand treasure, and it is home to abundant aquatic life, including the region's rare and endangered giant clam species. From the coast of Jasaan, a 40-minute boat ride is needed to reach the island. While on the boat ride, get a clear view of the shorelines of Misamis Oriental or make little splashes in the crystal-clear waters.



## ILPLS

📍 Initao-Libertad,  
Mis Or.

The Initao-Libertad Protected Landscape and Seascape covers a sprawling area of 1,300.78 hectares, safeguarding the pristine limestone forests known as "Lasang" in the local Bisaya language, and the surrounding marine waters in Initao and Libertad municipalities. This protected area serves as a vital sanctuary for both land and marine biodiversity. The park also preserves the last remaining stand of old-growth forest in the province of Misamis Oriental. It houses century-old trees, including the Talisay Gubat.



## Seven Seas Waterpark & Resort

This world-class attraction lets you experience state-of-the-art facilities with over 12 different thrilling slides, a 5,000-square-meter dual wave pool, a 400-meter-long lazy river, and many more family-friendly attractions and amenities. Seven Seas Waterpark has been hailed as the best waterpark in Mindanao since its early years. This attraction is a thrill-seekers' wonderland prepared to serve you with a fun-filled, action-packed day!



## Gingoog Pier

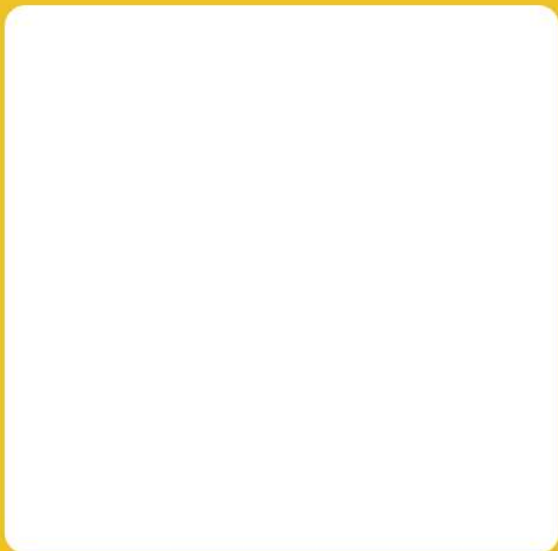
📍 Gingoog City,
